of different things to Elastic.

What does it mean to be distributed?

Build into culture and ideas as close to origin as possible

- Began before we were, well, a company.
 - Founders in Israel, Germany, and the Netherlands
 - Work **began** in a distributed way
 - Location of people is only one 'attribute' to a person
- DNA for distribution is also in our product
 - **Open source** software is distributed with contributors **everywhere**
 - **Community** is key to everything
 - If a product can scale distributed, **why not** a company?
- Thinking differently about how and where we grow & **scale**
 - Not landlocked by one region
 - Why limit yourself by region e.g. NE Ohio?
 - **Luxury** of hiring best fit wherever they are
 - We hire **diversity** by design and mix cultures daily

Scaling, communicating, learning, reviewing processes, and trusting

- Asynchronous by default, synchronous when needed
 - Broadcast communication is more effective. Use **defined** tools and processes
 - Email and GitHub are books of record
 - Present at **multiple** times for global synchronous needs
- **Trust** everyone. Assume no malice.
 - Prevent a 9-5 mindset
 - Provide **tools** to record everything; GitHub, Slack, Zoom
 - Freedom and **inclusivity** are keys to success
- **Scaling**
 - X-school, Always On, Cross Team Time, Release Parties, All Hands
 - Offices
 - Available in most cities if you want to go in
 - Co-working **credit** if you prefer that
 - **Money** for home office expenses, and partnerships with key vendors
